Why is your vehicle being recalled?	Your vehicle was equipped with an ARC front-driver airbag inflator that could over pressurize during airbag deployment and rupture. If the front-driver airbag inflator ruptures during deployment, the airbag may not fully inflate, and the release of high-pressured gas may propel pieces of the inflator and airbag module into the occupant compartment, causing or increasing the risk of injury to occupant(s) in a crash.
What will we do?	Parts to repair your vehicle are not currently available , but when parts are available, your GM dealer will replace the front-driver airbag module. This service will be performed for you at no charge .
	We are working as quickly as possible to correct this condition. When parts are available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to your GM dealer to have your vehicle serviced.
